

COVID UPDATE 5/11/20

Dear Hurst Animal Clinic family,

We miss you guys! We hope you and your family have been doing well during these times of the new reality of COVID 19 America. Everyone here has been doing well and has been staying safe!

The Tarrant County Executive order recently expired, and Governor Abbot has been encouraging Texas to reopen slowly in phases. This has resulted in our protocols changing slightly almost every few days to try to maintain the best balance to take care of your pets, your health and our health. While we transition to a normal life over the next few months, the best thing to do to keep updated is to give us a call at 817-282-1463.

Important updates so far:

- 1) We are still currently doing drop offs and curbside service for all services except boarding to minimize personal contact. We are fully open for grooming now as well! Please bring your cell phone as we are doing most of these services and keeping in contact by phone.
- 2) Nail trims and anal gland expressions have resumed, though they may take longer than you are accustomed to due to our staff's increase workload with the curbside workflow.
- 3) We are still running sick appointments only for Saturdays to make sure we are available for those patients that need us the most while keeping everyone at safe distances. These appointments currently can only be made on Saturday morning starting at 8 by either showing up or calling from home.

We also provide anal gland expressions, toenail trims, follow up lab work due, and prescription refills during Saturdays until noon.
